

PL 415 Execution Plans

This course provides value-added site design and engineering skills and techniques to ensure that the planned project meets the intended purpose. In general, the course focuses on the design, coordination and appropriateness of the project site, streets, lots, open spaces and community facilities. In addition to such matters as topography and stormwater runoff are evaluated as relate to the planned subdivision as well as the planning for the surrounding neighbourhoods. This course focuses on teaching the student how to use innovative site design techniques that ensure compatibility of the project with the landform.
